
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## **SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

- 1/4 yd organza
- 1/2 yd tulle
- Hair comb
- Small pearl beads
- Small crystal beads
- Thread
- Needle
- Scissors
- Chalk or marking pen
- Ruler

## **DIRECTIONS:**


1. Cut 28"x12" piece of tulle. Cut off 4" corners at top (FIG A).



- 2. Attach corner of comb to lower corner of tulle. Hand baste around sides and top edge of tulle with cut corners. Do not stitch the long straight edge.
- 3. Pull thread taut to gather the netting. Before stitching the netting to the comb, try on the veil. Make any adjustments to the amount of tulle to fit now.
- 4. Hand stitch the gathered tulle to the straight part of the comb. Secure with a few stitches and a knot.
- 5. To make a flower, cut out three 5" circle of organza and two 5" circles of tulle.



6. Cut flowers shapes out of tulle and organza (FIG B).





- 7. Layer the tulle & organza. Pinch layers in the center. Stitch center of layers to secure flower. Make as many flowers as desired. Set aside.
- 8. Cut 5" leaf shapes out of organza and tulle (FIG C).



- 9. Attach leaves & flowers to comb with needle & thread.
  Place leaves between & around flowers for a whispy, feathered look.
- 10. Hand stitch beads onto veil.
