SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 1/2 yd. ea. of Polyester shantung, satin, or other shiny fabric: red & green
- 3 Decorative buttons
- 1 yd. Ribbon or cord
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine
- Iron & ironing surface

DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut one of each fabric 13" wide by 14" high.
2. With right sides facing, sew around sides and top.
3. Clip corners, turn and press.
4. Bring sides together, overlapping by 1/2". Pin in place.
5. Turn inside out and stitch along the open bottom. Sew across ends of bottom seam, making box corners. Trim off the triangle points and zig-zag raw edges.
6. Turn, place bottle in cover, and pin together the overlap.
7. Sew buttons on overlapping section.
8. Tie cord or bow around neck and fold the top back exposing the contrasting color.
