

cupcake pillow

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
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SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 1/2 yd Fabric (A)
- 1/4 yd Fabric (B)
- Two 18" squares batting or muslin
- Polyester fiberfill
- Rickrack
- 2" pompom
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine

DIRECTIONS: Refer to photo. Use a 1/2" seam allowance. RS=Right side(s) WS= Wrong side(s)

- Enlarge pattern to measurements noted. Place cupcake top pattern on top of cupcake bottom pattern, slightly overlapping bottom with top. Tape pattern together. Trace pattern to each batting or muslin foundation square. Set aside.
- 2. From Fabric B cut two 6½"x11½" rectangles for cupcake bottom.
- 3. From Fabric A cut two 17"x21" rectangles for cupcake top. Gather the 2 longer sides of each rectangle.
- 4. With RS together and raw edges even, stitch cupcake top to cupcake bottom, matching centers. Cupcake top piece will be wider than needed.
- 5. Adjust side gathers to fit & pin pieced unit to a foundation square. Baste 1/4" within traced line.
- 6. Cut out cupcake on traced line. Repeat for back of pillow.
- 7. Stitch rickrack to bottom of cupcake.
- 8. With RS together, stitch cupcake pieces together, leaving an opening for turning.
- 9. Turn and stuff pillow. Whip-stitch opening closed.
