Fringed Fleece Scarf

**Supplies:**

2 yards fleece  
Basic sewing supplies

**Directions:**

Cutting lengthwise, cut 27" x 72" piece of fleece.  
Cut 9" square from each corner.  
To make fringe, cut 9" into fleece at 1/2" intervals around all four sides of fleece.  
Tie fringe as desired.

**Tip:** To make scarf longer, cut two 27" x 72" pieces of fleece. Stitch ends of fleece pieces together. Finish seam allowance as desired.
