


Furry Friend Bath Bib



Trace paw-prints onto the paper-backed fusible web. Fuse to the wrong side of applique fabric. Cut out on the traced lines; peel paper backing away. Arrange as desired along the lower portion of the towel; fuse in place.

Using a satin stitch, blanket stitch, or feather stitch, applique the shapes in place, positioning a layer of tear-away stabilizer behind the towel under the shapes, if needed.

At the opposite end of the towel, stitch the button to one corner using a Button Sew-on Foot (BERNINA® #18).




Next time you give your furry friend a bath, stay dry wearing this clever bib, fashioned from a bath towel. It's also handy for bundling your pet once bathtime's over! Variation: Applique or embroider baby motifs (blocks, teddy bears, etc.) on the towel for a unique baby shower gift!

Supplies

- Bath towel
- One larger (11/4" or larger) button
- 5" 6" sturdy cord or braid
- Fabric scraps for applique
- Paper-backed fusible web
- Thread to coordinate with towel and appliques
- Tear-away stabilizer
- Button Sew-on Foot (BERNINA® #18)

Machines

- BERNINA® sewing machine
- Most other sewing machines



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
