



Reversible Charm Apron



Materials

Twenty one 5" x 5" charm squares


1 yard coordinating fabric for lining, waistband and ties

Matching thread


Marking pencil

NOTE: All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise indicated.

Sew charm squares into rows as shown in fig. 1



Assemble rows as indicated. Trim as shown in fig. 2



Lay apron over lining fabric wrong sides together, taking care to smooth any folds. Pin apron to lining and using marking pencil, trace carefully around apron. Remove apron and cut out lining.

Lay apron over lining wrong sides together. Baste all edges.

Binding

Cut two 2" by width of fabric strips. Join and press wrong sides together to form binding. Bind sides and bottom of apron.

Waistband and Ties

Cut three 3" by width of fabric strips.

Measure top of apron and cut one strip to the same measurement. Join a strip to each side of waistband.

Press wrong sides together. Turn in and press ½" along all four sides. Find center of strip. Open out and pin waistband to center of top of apron, right sides together. Stitch waistband to top of apron.

Fold waistband and ties wrong sides together and pin. Topstitch through all thicknesses, catching back of waistband to apron and finishing tie ends.
